MAINS ONLY

This is a power management fun fly and not only will you have fun, but you may learn something too 😊!

Requirements:

Minimum 46” Wingspan

Can be a tricycle or tail dragger type airplane

Floats are NOT acceptable!

Rules:

The objective is to match your take-off time with your landing time. The lowest time difference wins. On the landing roll, try to travel between the starting line and finish line on the main wheels only.

1. The plane will start the take-off roll before the starting line and at the end of the take-off roll (the finish line) the plane will take-off. Timer starts at entry and stops at the finish-line. 1 second per foot penalty for early take-off.
2. Land on the mains only before the starting line and roll through to the finish line, but on the landing, once the mains touch you can adjust the throttle before the starting line but after the starting line “hands off the throttle” and coast as long as you can without the nose or tail gear touching down. Timer starts at entry and stops at the finish line. If the plane’s nose or tail touches before the finish line the timer stops. 1 second per foot penalty for tail or nose gear touching down before the finish-line, on the landing. If the plane lands after the starting line there will be a 1 second per foot penalty.
3. Subtract the low time from the high time, the lowest time difference wins

Notes: on the landing the plane cannot stop and then power up and continue.

Field set-up:

1. There will be a starting line and a finish line on the runway. The lines will be 10 feet apart and marked using duct tape.
2. Each foot between the lines will be marked off for spot verification.
